EXTENSION OF ACADEMIC ORBIT ALONG WITH PATRIOTISM

After summer break, regular physical classes were started in the first week of July with utmost enthusiasm. The First UT exam was conducted from 20 to 27 July 2022 followed by Half-Yearly & UT2 exams in the month of Sep and Dec. Annual Exam was held in the month of March 2023 where the cadets performed exceptionally well. The new academic session was commenced on 01 April 2023 with a resolution to give better performance in the succeeding year.

NTA conducted the Entrance Examination for Sainik Schools (AISSEE) on 08 Jan 2023 and its result for class VIth and IXth was declared on 24 Feb 2023 followed by e-counselling and medical examination in District Hospital and Military Hospital Jhansi. After the completion of entire process 81 cadets in class VI and 15 cadets in class IX have been admitted in school.

Sainik School Jhansi has been allocated 100 JD/JW Vacancies under 56 UP Bn NCC Jhansi. 90 Cadets were enrolled from class IXth. The school has taken up a case pending for additional 80 JD/JW vacancies from NCC Dte UP through 56 NCC Bn for enrollment of cadets of class VIIIth. The case has been forwarded by NCC Dte Lucknow to DG NCC, Delhi for sanction.

A smart classroom is an EdTech-upgraded classroom that enhances the teaching and learning process for both teachers and the students by inculcating audio, video, animations, images, multimedia etc. Sainik School Jhansi installed Three New Smart Classes for interactive studies which will enhance teaching-learning process.

We, in Sainik School Jhansi, throughout the year, participate in all the activities assigned by MoE, MoD, CBSE such as activities under Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsava, Veer Gatha, Writing & Role Playing Activities on Freedom Fighters under Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat, 'Har-Ghar Tiranga' Campaign Mai Bhi Subhash Campaign to evoke a sense of patriotism along with academic zeal among cadets.


The event provided cadets an opportunity to showcase their talent in co-curricular activities and interact with the teachers and officers in a more informal environment.

Holi Celebration



RECRUITMENT OF ACADEMIC STAFF ON REGULAR BASIS



Recruitment process is the first step in creating a powerful resource base. The process undergoes a systematic approach of collecting and reviewing resumes, conducting job interviews, and finally selecting and onboarding the right candidates to start working for the organization. Written exam and personal interview for the posts of TGT English, S.St., Hindi, Sanskrit, Science, Maths (Regular Basis) and PTI cum Matron, Librarian, Lab Assistant, Office Superintendent, Art Master (Contractual Basis) were conducted respectively on 10-11 Sep and 01-06 Oct 2022 in Sainik School, Jhansi. The selected candidates for the posts of PTI cum Matron, Art Master, Librarian, Lab Assistant (Cont Basis), TGT English, S.St., Hindi, Sanskrit, Science, Maths (Regular Basis) have joined the school respectively in the month of Oct and Nov 2022.



CONSTRUCTION ON TRACK: BUILDING A BETTER HALTON



The school building is planned to be constructed in two phases. The first phase consists of Administrative and Academic buildings, dining hall, three hostels, sewage treatment plant, staff accommodation, parade ground, sports ground and various courts. Whereas the second phase consists Swimming Pool, Additional Hostel, MP Theatre, Additional Staff Accommodation etc. Laying of internal and peripheral road, development of sports infrastructure, construction of Parade Ground, laying of sewage pipeline and water pipeline, construction of Sewage Treatment Plant is under progress. The PDC for the completion of the same is extended till August 2023.

With the induction of AY 2023-24, sports infrastructure of the school has been upgraded to involve and encourage the cadets towards sports

games. Leveling of sports ground has been completed. Football, Volleyball, Badminton and Hockey grounds have been made ready for the cadets and are being utilized. Work Services for synthetic Running Track is under progress and likely to be completed in August 2023 under Phase-I of the project by UPRNNL. Apart from outdoor games, cadets are encouraged to involve themselves in indoor games such as Table Tennis, Carrom Board and Chess for which the required infrastructure has been established.




To invoke a sense of patriotism and nationality among cadets and staff, Construction of Monumentation Flag was completed in School Campus. Lt Gen Vipul Shinghal, SM, Corps Commander, 21 Corps inaugurated it on 27 Sep 2022.

Encouraging the physical activities among cadets, the school has constructed Multi Chin up and Pull up Bar, Sit up Bar and Parallel Dips Bar. The school has also constructed the structure for Rope Gallows to enhance cadets' physical activities.

Science and Maths Labs have been updated in school to give first-hand learning experience of the topics to the cadets by performing several experiments. The school has upgraded the labs to facilitate the teacher to explain the scientific and mathematical concepts to the cadets in better and practical manner by using concrete objects, models, charts, graphs and pictures.

Sainik School Jhansi has set up an English Language Lab where the cadets are being given practical classes in the laboratory environment for practicing and assessing one's speech in English, Hindi, and Sanskrit. It provides a facility which allows the cadets to Listen to model pronunciation, repeat and record the same, listen to their performance and compare with model and do self-assessment.









Installation of Solar Plant for Administrative Building

In order to minimize energy consumption, Sainik School Jhansi has come up with the installation of Solar Power Plant. Solar Modules, Invertor, Structure, Cables, Wires, Conduit pipes, MCCBs and other accessories arrived in Sainik School Jhansi. Modules and material were lifted to roof using Hydra machinery, after which structure mounting was started accordingly 185nos. Adani 540ep Mono-Perc Half cut modules are used to achieve maximum efficiency, were mounted Furthermore 2x50KW Growatt String inverters were installed in the LT room of admin block of the Sainik School with all DC and AC wiring with protection boxes. Solar Project installation was completed in the first week of April and net metering file is pending at DVVNL Jhansi.



Mini Auditorium

Sainik School Jhansi has come up with a mini auditorium from the partition of dining hall. The auditorium is a central and important space in school which is used for all types of Formal Assembly, Lectures, Award Ceremonies, Dramatic Plays, Musical and Dance Competitions. The inauguration of the same is planned in the 6th LBA Meeting.


