
# Cultural Evening on Posting In/Out of Principal



#### RECRUITMENT OF ACADEMIC STAFF

Recruitment for various positions on a contractual basis at Sainik School Jhansi took place, targeting roles crucial for holistic cadet development and academic support. The positions included Counselor, responsible for providing guidance and support to cadet; Music Teacher and Art Master, nurturing creative talents; Lab Assistant in Biology, ensuring smooth laboratory operations; Librarian, facilitating access to knowledge resources; and PTI-Cum-Matron & OS, managing physical education and overseeing hostel affairs.

The selection process likely involved rigorous screening to ensure candidates possessed the requisite qualifications, experience, and passion for working in an educational environment. Contractual appointments offer flexibility to both the school and employees while addressing staffing needs efficiently.

Such recruitment drives reflect the school's commitment to providing a well-rounded education and fostering a conducive learning environment. By engaging professionals in diverse fields, Sainik School Jhansi aims to enrich cadets' educational journey beyond conventional academics. These contractual positions also offer opportunities for professionals to contribute meaningfully to the school's mission on a temporary basis, potentially paving the way for long-term collaborations based on performance and organizational needs. The selected candidates for the post of Music, Art Master, Lab Asst Bio, Librarian & PTI-Cum-Matron joined the school on 20 Nov 2023. In a nutshell, the recruitment process underscores the school's dedication to holistic education and comprehensive cadet support.

Considering the imminent onset of class XI in the approaching Academic Session, namely AY 2024-25, the necessity for permanent personnel comprising PGTs, TGTs, Lab Assistants, and a Medical Officer becomes unequivocally indispensable to ensure the seamless operation and academic excellence of the school. Last date for receiving the application form for said posts was 23 March 2024. After the scrutiny of application forms, the interview was scheduled in the first week of April 2024.









#### CONSTRUCTION ON TRACK: BUILDING A BETTER HALTON

The school building is planned to be constructed in two phases. The first phase consists of Administrative and Academic buildings, dining hall, three hostels, sewage treatment plant, staff accommodation, parade ground, sports ground and various courts. Whereas the second phase consists Swimming Pool, Additional Hostel, MP Theatre, Additional Staff Accommodation etc. The PDC for the completion of the same is extended till April 2024. With the induction of AY 2023-24, sports infrastructure of the school has been upgraded to involve and encourage the cadets towards sports and games. Leveling of sports ground has been completed. Football, Volleyball, Badminton and Hockey grounds are ready for the cadets and are being utilized. Work Services for synthetic Running Track is under progress and likely to be completed in April 2024 under Phase-II of the project by UPRNNL. Apart from outdoor games, cadets are also encouraged to involve themselves in indoor games such as Table Tennis, Carrom Board and Chess for which the required infrastructure has been established.

### Inauguration of Mini Auditorium

Sainik School Jhansi has come up with a Mini Auditorium 'Khetrapal' from the partition of dining hall. The auditorium is a central and important space in school which is used for all types of formal assembly lectures, award ceremonies, dramatic plays, musical and dance competitions. The inauguration of the same was done by LBA Chairman Maj Gen M K Mathur, General Officer Commanding, 31 Armd Div Jhansi on 10 Jul 2023.



#### Girls Hostel

The Work Services for construction of Girls Hostel were commenced with construction of boundary wall on 17 Jan 2022. Internal plaster work, iron window work, plumbing, electrical work of first floor, construction of RCC beds and RCC study table along with whitewash and putty of the external wall has been completed. Installation of Y-Angle on the boundary wall and painting of Girls Hostel is in progress. Provisioning of interlocking tiles in the Hostel premises is underway. Hence, the work services of the girls 'hostel are 99% completed. PMG along with the team of UPRNNL carried out a detailed survey of the building and the agency was informed for early completion of work.



#### Parking Shed

A vehicle parking shed was constructed in the month of August in Sainik School Jhansi for school vehicles as part of deposit work under the Infrastructure Grant for FY 2022-23. The final survey of the same is still pending.



### Installation Concerting Fencing

The installation of concertina fencing, Y-angle and barbed wire was done in Sainik School, Jhansi, for the purpose of ensuring the security and safety of the school. The final survey of the same is still pending.



#### Establishing Selfie Points

Sainik School Jhansi introduced selfie points to foster cadets' engagement and showcase campus culture. Strategically placed at scenic spots, these points encourage social sharing and create memorable moments. The initiative enhances school branding and strengthens the bond between cadets and their alma mater, promoting a sense of pride and belonging.



Under the 'One School-One Sport' initiative of Sainik Schools Society, Ministry of Defence, Sainik School Jhansi has been allotted Hockey as the sport under 'One State-One Sport'. It is proposed to construct Hockey Ground (AstroTruf) at Sainik School Jhansi. This infrastructure would give appropriate facility for conducting Hockey Game at this school for the cadets thereby enabling them to hone their skills and prepare them for national and international representation in future.
